

MARRIED LIFE

“For your Maker is your husband, The LORD of hosts is His name; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth.”
(Isaiah 54:5, NKJV)

Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.” (Revelation 19:7, NKJV)

Have you ever noticed that many scriptures in the Bible refer to our relationship with God as Him being our husband and the church His bride? Not any other family relationship but His bride! This points to the truth of marriage being an institution ordained by God and that of a covenantal nature.

The institution of marriage is God’s idea. Timothy Keller wrote in The Meaning of Marriage,

“At the climax of Genesis account of creation, we see God bringing a woman and a man together to unite in marriage. The bible begins with wedding (of Adam and Eve) and ends in the book of Revelation with a wedding (of Christ and the church)... If God invented marriage, then those who enter it should make every effort to understand and submit to His purpose for it.”

The institution of marriage is God’s design to fulfil the primarily three purposes: the functional purpose, the sacramental purpose and the purpose of sanctifying one another. This exciting journey of fulfilling the purposes help us to unravel the mystery (Eph 5:31 – 33) a little better until the day of the Lord. Therefore, the institution of marriage not only needs to be strengthened to face the increasing challenges but to be strengthened to fulfil the original intent of marriage.

“Let Marriage be held in honour among all.....” Hebrews 13:4

This is the desire that every husband and wife has. However, in reality, we know that every husband and wife relationship has different challenges, and more than often they face them alone.

The focus of the Married Life is to leverage on the body of Christ to strengthen marital relationship through the new Marriage Preparatory and Discipleship Programme (MPDP) and Marriage Partnering Programme (MPP).

a) The new MPDP is a programme designed for couples who are preparing to marry. It is conducted over 12 sessions with one marriage mentor couple. The first six sessions are conducted with two or three couples in a home setting before the wedding. The remaining six sessions are conducted with individual couples after the wedding. These six post-wedding sessions are important as no amount of preparation for marriage will be adequately sufficient.

b) The MPP is a programme designed for married couples who are interested to develop a stronger marital relationship. The MPP is conducted over a 12 sessions which covers the elements of marriage through applying the biblical principles in their marriage.

The hope of the new setup is to build strong relationship with another couple so that good practices can be shared and pitfalls can be avoided through authentic sharing founded on biblical truths and practices. May each marriage lay the foundation for strong families loving Jesus and passing the heritage to another generation. May each household burn and shine brightly for Jesus and giving warmth and light to those who needed them.



PARENTING LIFE



So, the people served the Lord all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD which HE had done for Israel. Now Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the LORD died when he was hundred and ten years old.

*When all that generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation arose after them who did not know the LORD nor the work which HE had done for Israel. **Judges chapter 2:7,8,10***

It is incomprehensible why Joshua and his generation who saw God as big and mighty and did many wonders and defeated several armies, did not pass the baton to the next generation. Today our baton is Jesus Christ and we must persevere in passing this baton to our children and the next generation.

*For I have chosen him so that he may command his children and his household after him to keep the way of the LORD by doing righteousness and justice, so that the LORD may bring upon Abraham what he has spoken about him. **Genesis 18:19***

Also, observe that God promised Abraham in Genesis 18 verse 19 that he would bring upon Abraham what he has spoken of **after** Abraham would command his children and household to keep the way of the Lord. This is how important the transfer of faith is for us to see God's promises bear fruit in our lives.

Many churches in the world have witnessed their young members who have just come of age leaving church. Why is this so?

One of the most important reasons are that the older generation has not successfully passed the faith that was given to them in Christ Jesus through the Holy Spirit to their offspring thus resulting in a depleting number of youth in our churches today. Many of our young ones today are faced with many challenges such as pressures at school, peer influences, choices in career, exam worries, temptations lurking around each corner, which in turn makes them prioritise their school work and other activities over God's Word, thereby, resulting in poor attendance at church. This in turn over the years reduces their hearing of the Word thereby reducing faith. We parents may even sometimes face a day when our little ones' question going to church altogether. One of the most crucial questions that may come to their minds at some point could also be that 'Is Christianity right for me? Is this really the truth? Must I continue to follow my parents to church and fellowship? Why can't I take a break from church?'

If we believe that the only way to eternal life in heaven is through faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, then the Bible says that faith comes by hearing the word of God. As we live in a time of an open heaven, we can receive our spiritual manna or bread in rich abundance in the house of God which is the church, the body of Christ.

"So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God". Romans 10:17.

These are situations you may have faced or possibly could face as parents. You may be overwhelmed by these questions and may ask yourself 'How do I prevent this? How do I prepare myself to answer this if my child asks me sooner or later? My child is making excuses about going to church, how do I encourage him and get him to attend church with us?'

At Grace Assemblies, we would go through the Word of God and would like to partner with you as you may face these situations especially as your precious one/ones are entering their foundational pre-school and primary school years.

As we enter the new the year of 2017, we are happy to share with you the vision we have at our **Parenting Life Ministry**.

Our main objectives are to....

- Bring awareness to parents about the need to fulfil their God-given role as Godly parents through participating in our 'Faith Begins at Home Inaugural Programme'
- Provide family bonding platforms through organising family outings and events.
- Establish a discipleship track by providing regular equipping and training for parenting partners and partnering with the children's ministry.
- Organise family mission experiences.

Please look out for further announcements for our 'Alpha Parenting for Children and Teens' sessions to be held this year 2017. These will be conducted through interactive group sessions so parents can share their experiences and encourage other parents.

Wholeness Ministry Vision for 2017

Many Christians are not living a victorious life, and many feel they are living in bondage, feeling trapped, wounded, helpless and even hopeless – a spectrum of issues varying from generational bondages to issues of rejection, anger, unforgiveness, bitterness, negative patterns, sexual sins and childhood hurts. In Wholeness Ministry, we address these deep-rooted issues by using the 'Restoring the Foundation (RTF) integrated approach'. We deal with four sources of wounding, namely,

- Consequences of generational iniquity, which is removing the pressure to sin (it is also known as sins of our forefathers and resulting curses (or SOFCs) in RTF).
- Ungodly beliefs
- Soul/spirit hurts (healing of our hurts and pain)
- Demonic oppression

The seminars are conducted in lecture format with role play, testimonies, and prophetic prayer. After the seminar, individual ministry sessions are scheduled.

In Wholeness ministry, we would like to see each believer experience the Father's heart of God, love of Jesus, and the healing of the Holy Spirit.

As sons and daughters of God, we should live in freedom and victory.

An encouraging testimony after attending an inner healing workshop....

I believe it was on the second night of the course that an altar call was given to receive a prophetic word from God. I bravely stepped forward and waited when a sister came forward to pray for me and said that she saw the word 'brokenness' while praying for me. It was true as I was experiencing heart break due to some misunderstanding in a family relationship. When she asked me if this word "brokenness" meant

"So, do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand". Isaiah 41:10

anything to me, I immediately said yes. I was in awe of how the Holy Spirit revealed this information to her. The issue that I was facing was a misunderstanding in my relationship with my nieces and nephews. Our relationship was strained. What I did was misinterpreted as negative and interfering. I was hurt by them. As I stood there, the sister prayed for reconciliation. God worked in such a marvellous way and not long after that altar call and prayer, reconciliation actually took place. My brother and sister-in-

law did not blame me anymore that my niece had become a Christian. My relationship with me niece and nephew also began to improve. The prophetic word I received that day was being fulfilled.

The Holy Spirit also reminded me of certain disturbing childhood memories when my pet was murdered by a neighbour, and my relatives looked down on us and left leftovers for us to eat. I believe the Holy Spirit wanted to heal me of these deep-rooted feelings and fears. This ministry that I attended was truly a blessing to me. I believe it is beneficial for every Christian to attend, no matter how big or small our problems may be. I would like to add that one of my godly beliefs is: Having freedom in Christ, I am a new creation, loved by God. He upholds me with His righteous right hand and I don't need to fight for recognition.

Another uplifting testimony

Briefly tell us what your life was like before God ministered to you. What were your struggles?

My marriage turned sour in 2010. I sought counselling from a family service centre between 2010 to 2013 and I had a divorce in 2012. I fell into depression and was hospitalised at the Institute of Mental Health

Now the LORD is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the LORD is there is freedom.

2 Corinthians 3:17

in 2013. At that time, I was taking medication to treat my depression and anxiety. Since then, I lost interest in spiritual things and preferred to stay away from people. Life was hard and painful and the future seemed bleak to me. I felt worthless and helpless.

How has God changed your life as you received ministry?

As I began to receive ministry through Grace Wholeness ministry, I felt touched by God personally. During the sessions, I recalled many past hurting incidents and felt that God came and took away all these hurts. The fact that Jesus was there with me was healing by itself. I did feel the difference after the ministry sessions. For example, my obsession

Psalms 34:18

on the topic of death was gone. I no longer felt drawn to pick up books or watch YouTube videos on that topic. I no longer felt heavy and oppressed in my spirit. My mind became clear and I seemed to have more energy. I was able to focus on my job better, embrace more activities, be less fearful, and my problems were solved well.

"Oh Lord my God I cried to you for help, and you have healed me"

Psalms 30:2

What are some blessings and victories you have experienced as you work out your Christian life after the ministry?

After the ministry, Jesus took away my shame and guilt. Love, joy, peace, hope, confidence, security and self-control entered into my heart. I no longer felt chained. I felt a new freedom to move forward and pursue a future in my job and in my life. I have recently started attending a care cell regularly after I had stopped for two years.

Any word for those who have yet to step out to receive this ministry?

For those who are yet to step out and receive this ministry, I would like to say that if you cannot move forward in your life, you may be chained by your past. Help yourself like I did. God can do for you what you cannot do for yourself. Come and experience God's delivering power. Do not waste any more time and energy struggling on your own. After God has helped you, you can move forward in your life and you can help others as well.

Any other comments?

Though my psychiatrist, who was from a Baptist background, told me that my experience was more psychological than spiritual, after much pondering I concluded that it was more spiritual than psychological. God had healed me in a deeper level where counselling, psychiatric treatment, self-help books and self-talk could not reach me. Things turned around in a mysterious yet amazing way in my recent encounter with God. I literally felt like Jesus came to where I was and walked me out of darkness into His light. The yolk of slavery was broken by the power of God. He broke my chains and set me free from my bondages, turned my sorrow into joy, took my burden and gave me rest, I felt alive once again.

What I experienced spiritually happens concurrently in real life. The transformation is authentic and real. My ability to focus on my job, share insightful views during meetings, problems solved effectively, renewed hunger for God, knowledge and skill acquisition, higher tolerance level towards others are evidenced in my life that this is definitely supernatural. God has indeed touched and healed me. He is the glory and the lifter of my head. God is good all the time and all the time God is good. I have truly experienced it for myself. To Him be the glory! Amen

"See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland."
 - Isaiah 43:19

Globalisation has changed a lot of what we thought was missions. Countries are closing up to the idea of having missionaries converting their people thus making missionary visas increasingly difficult to get. Gone were the days where people go into the villages to stay. Today's missionaries now go to the cities instead to set up base. Usually they would set up businesses and/or open an NGO or study at an institution — these are used as platforms in order to reach out to the masses.

So for all of you who think you are not missions-inclined, not so adventurous, think again.

"For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." - Ephesians 2:10

You can do something for Jesus, whether you are young or old, regardless of profession. For those of you who are jet setters, instead of asking yourself if you are able to do missions like the missionaries do, ask yourself a simpler question "am I willing to relocate?" Internet connects us, and you can always fly home to visit family and friends. They are just a few hours away.

A team of us consisting of 10 adults and 2 children ages ranging from 8 to 60, went on a family missions trip to Cambodia in mid-November. The purpose of the trip was to visit government schools in villages to share the story of Jesus with primary school students.

During the trip, we visited 10 local families and prayed for them. We also visited 2 churches and conducted programmes for the children, youth and adults. One thing that really struck us was that, there was this woman with intestinal cancer who looked downcast during our home visitation at her place. But at the service she was filled with joy as she praised God. It was heartening to see what God is doing in her life and we continued to proclaim the power of Jesus to wholly restore her. We also prayed for our Cambodian partners that God would guide them in their vision for each of their lives.

For 3 days, we went to 5 government schools and reached out to about 1,000 students. We engaged them with catchy songs and performed two skits to introduce the concept of sin and how Jesus' sacrifice cleanses our sin. We also taught all the students how to make a 5-coloured bracelet that illustrated the Jesus Story.

One of the principals mentioned that no missions team has ever visited his school and we are thankful to God that the principals, teachers and students were welcoming and gave us the privilege to minister to them.

Most importantly, praise God for allowing us to meet the students, despite uncertainties during our planning process, language barriers, and the hot weather in their schools' open fields. But we all enjoyed each others' presence and playing games with each other.

On my way back to Singapore, I was reminded about focusing on God and surrendering all to Him and His direction. He should be the first priority in our lives. Through this trip, even though we were supposed to bless the Cambodians, I feel that we have been more blessed by God through them. It was obvious that God has touched our team despite having a wide variance in age and having come from different personal and spiritual backgrounds.

The Myanmar Missions team consisting of 21 trippers from all ages went on a trip in December 2016. 7 of us went up north to Pokokku in Magway Province after one day of ministry in Yangon while the rest stayed on in Yangon to do ministry.

In addition to ministering at multiple local churches and training the local leaders, we held a medical camp for 83 villagers. It was almost unbelievable to be given the chance to serve the people, share the gospel and pray for the sick at the monastery.

Our team joined in the heavenly celebrations for one precious soul saved at the monastery. The monastery staff and monks were thankful for our services to the villagers. They even opened

the door to the local church and invited them to carol and share the Christmas story during Christmas at the monastery. They also accepted Ps Ki Tam's invitation to join in the Christmas festivities at the local church. What a God-given opportunity!

Those of us in Yangon had a wonderful time of ministry with the youths, children and women. We hosted a youth camp for about 50 enthusiastic youths and shared bible stories with hundreds of children in various churches.

In one church, our team conducted bible study on the book of Jonah to 50 women and gave them a cooking demonstration of two Singapore dishes- radish cake and bamboo soup. Everyone had a good time fellowshiping and sharing tips on cooking.

We witnessed 32 adults and hundreds of children giving their lives to Jesus! What a mighty harvest we had! What a mighty God we serve! All glory to God in the highest! Won't you sign up for a mission trip this year?


