In partnership with some of the churches in India, a team from Grace Missions went to do a series of medical camps in the village areas in August 2017. This series of medical camps consisted of the team from Grace Missions together with Indian doctors and volunteers from the local churches.

Everyone serving in the camps, be it Singaporean or Indian, all took leave from their work, sacrificed their money and skills for this Kingdom work. I believe that this is what real partnership looks like — that we all put our hands to the plough together.

The most interesting fact about the team from Grace Missions is that none of us are medically trained, but this does not mean we are rendered useless in a medical camp.

My team took the 'prayer station' and did ministry among the children. At the prayer station, We saw quite a number of documented healings, with doctor's confirmation.

The deaf hear, the paralysed managed to walk again, and the most amazing testimony of them all was that of a blind woman who regained her sight. That lady was totally blind. Her pupils were white in the center. She was brought to us by the doctors to be prayed for — the blind woman later sees! This dramatic healing was witnessed by everyone in the room. The faith and morale level of my team sky-rocketed with cheers going all around directed to Jesus Christ.

## MIRACLES in our MEDICAL CAMPS

It starts with the registration counter (extreme right), then the people are directed to respective stations (children, eye, women, general, chiropractic). After they are done with the stations, the people will head to the pharmacy, and then exit the area by going to the church to be prayed for. Some of my team are doing children ministry and some of us are at the church 'prayer station'.

I believe that God is showing us that our contribution to the medical camps is just as important as the doctors. Everyone is different and no one is better than another. Everyone is valuable in the Kingdom of God. This throws open the door for everyone, young and old, medically trained or untrained to participate and contribute in this kind of medical missions.

In 2018, Grace Missions is planning to make two trips to India to do medical camps like this. All are welcome. Do look out for it in next year's missions trip schedule!

# REFLECTIONS ON Study of MATTHEW Part 1

I enjoyed my inductive study of Matthew Part 1. Inductive bible study uses the Bible as the primary source of information about the Bible. It was joyful and fulfilling to discover truth for myself rather than rely on other people's insights to find out what the Bible says.

The study reminded me of the importance of a deep, personal relationship with Christ and the need for fruitfulness. Jesus said in the Sermon on the Mount that unless our righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, we will not enter the Kingdom of Heaven. The Pharisees taught outward compliance to God's Law, but Jesus taught that the righteousness needed to enter the Kingdom of Heaven is not just an outward righteousness but an inward righteousness as well. It is clearly a standard impossible for any man to attain by his own effort.

I realized that many times I try to earn or justify my salvation through obedience and good works. The video taught that righteousness is not a checklist, but a right standing with God and implies a relationship with Christ. Jesus warned that there would be many who think they are Christians, who called Him "Lord" and even performed miracles, but they would not be allowed into the Kingdom as they had no relationship with Him. True Christians bear good fruit, for a tree is known by its fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire. Only those who do the will of the Father are Jesus' family, and these will enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

In the busyness of work and ministry, it is easy to neglect my relationship with the Lord. Sometimes, laziness keeps me from spending needed time with Him. I now make prayer and quiet time a top priority by doing it first thing in the morning. I started examining myself to see if I am bearing fruit and if I have become complacent in my walk. Am I growing in the fruit of the Holy Spirit, serving in love and humility, and sharing the gospel with the unsaved? Am I seeking the Father's will and obeying? Do I truly love the Lord and have a vibrant relationship with Him, or am I practicing a legalistic religion? I found I needed to recommit some areas to the Lord.

Jesus tells His disciples that those who do not take up their cross and follow Him are not worthy of Him. I was convicted to examine if I am truly dying to self daily – to my own agenda, my desire for sinful pleasures and man's approval – and whether I truly live no longer for myself but for Him alone. For as the video highlighted repeatedly, Christ is not something that I add to my life, but Christ must replace my life.

Through this study, I have grown in knowledge of Jesus and what God requires of me as a disciple of Christ

and a child of His kingdom. My faith has grown, and I have become more reliant on the Holy Spirit, not only to illuminate Scripture, but to help me live the holy life God requires of me. Every lesson, the application questions help me pause and take stock of my spiritual life and re-align with God's heart and purposes. My prayer is that more ladies will sign up for these life transforming bible studies.

# TEEN REBELLION: Acting out or call for help?

Feels like you are in a losing battle with your rebellious teenager? Newsflash! It's not a battle so stop seeing it that way. It's not 'hapless parents' versus 'rebellious teens' however much it may seem like it. In fact if anything, unknowingly this perspective may well be fuelling the rebellion instead of helping to curb it.

Parents are often rendered helpless by their teens/pre-teens exhibiting what they consider objectionable behaviour. As a parent is your worry getting the better of you, with you getting carried away imagining the worst, sending a chill down your spine?

*"My teen and I can't seem to agree on anything all of a sudden causing stress and bad blood in the house setting a bad example for the younger siblings."*

*"My child is doing well academically but seems very dejected by something and is refusing to go to school."*

*"Recently, I chanced upon my teens self-harm behaviour and it had me worried sick but she just kept to herself, refused to share much."*

*"She used to be very obedient but of late seems to be easily agitated and often throws temper tantrums despite us trying our best to be supportive parents."*

*"Since starting secondary school, my child seems withdrawn and depressed but she keeps saying nothing is wrong. I can't help but worry."*

*"My child told us that she wants to find out more about all religions and will not be attending church with us anymore."*

*"My child plays online games till the wee hours and refuses to listen to us. It's affecting his grades and his health but it's like he is addicted!"*

*"My child does not seem to do well academically despite all the tuition provided while his siblings excel and I am unable to understand such great differences among my children."*

If any of this sounds familiar then you have a parenting crisis on your hands that may seem like it's too much to handle. And understandably so...

But could it be that your teen's rebellious streak is actually a shout out for help as they try and make sense of the world around them, except not in a way that you would think. Their call for help can be a tough balancing act requiring parents to give teens their space while lending them support as these young adults in the making try and find their way grappling with self-doubt, performance anxiety and emotional angst fueled by all the hormonal changes that come with being a teenager.

Most teens say they find their parents controlling with very high expectations while others feel their parents are often not there for them. There is a consensus that they want a strong parent-child relationship that is built on the basis of trust rather than authority. They want their parents to understand that their needs are different from what they used to be when they were younger and want their parents to be more of a coach rather than a provider and authority figure. They want to be heard and understood without judgement

and to be accepted as individuals in their own right rather than being mirror images of their parents.

The fact of the matter is that being rebellious, disrespectful, showing attitude are just symptoms and underneath there is a story that parents do not know about. We all have a story to tell, well, so do our children. The question then is how do parents keep the lines of communication open such that they can get to know their child's story given that parents and children tend to speak two entirely different languages?! Through the language of love, empathy and acceptance which is universal and can effectively break barriers.

Family Life Ministry is organising a talk cum workshop to help parents understand the workings of today's teens' inner world i.e. what makes them tick and what ticks them off.

This talk applies to parents:

- with children in their teens to know how to connect or re-connect with your child
- with children going to be teens to have a heads up to know how to prepare yourself when your child enters the teen zone.

She is a certified practitioner in EMDR (Eye Movement Desensitizing Reprocessing), a technique effective in treating trauma, depression, anger, anxiety and stress. # 'E' MOTION

Emotions are powerful. They can set us in "motion" even before we can think about what is happening. They can dictate our decisions over our rational mind. A person can do the most amazing things when fuelled by emotions. However, the opposite, sadly, is true too. Many tragedies happen when we are set in motion by our emotions.

When God created Adam and Eve, I believe He created them with the full capacity of emotions, not merely the physical being, and for a purpose too.

*Gen 1:26 ~ let Us make man in our image*

Since our God is the originator of emotions, He is able to comprehend all our feelings far better than any human on earth. He knows what it is like when we are down, and we feel good. Based on the accounts from the Bible in Old Testament, we see that God Himself has feelings too. He took delight over His people but also showed displeasure when His people lacked faith.

*Zeph 3:17 ~ "The LORD your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.*

*Psalms 149:4 ~ For the LORD takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the afflicted ones with salvation.*

*Exo 4:14 ~ Then the anger of the LORD burned against Moses,*

While it is easy for us to simply categorise emotions into positive and negative ones and endeavour to pursue the positive ones and avoid the negative, the reality is not as simple. God Himself burned with anger against Moses too but yet He is holy.

Jon Bloom, in his article, *Your Emotions Are a Gauge, Not a Guide* says, "God designed your emotions to be gauges, not guides. They're meant to report to you, not dictate you. The pattern of your emotions will give you a reading on where your hope is because they are wired into what you believe and value — and how much". In other words, God created us with the full range of emotions for a purpose. They indicate and give us a glimpse of what lies deeper in us.

I agree with Dr Peter Scazzero, author of *Emotionally Healthy Spirituality*, that our 'emotional health and spiritual maturity are inseparable. It is impossible to be spiritually mature while remaining emotionally immature'. I found this to be true, as I have witnessed many Christian brothers and sisters, even leaders in the church, struggling with how to handle and express their emotions. Instead of looking inward and dealing with the emotions, some avoid the emotions by putting on a smile to make others think that everything is fine, sometimes for the fear of being judged. This may eventually open up a platform for Satan to use these pent-up emotions to manipulate against them. Hence, some believers may still be living in condemnation and under the bondage of their emotions.

*Gal 5:1 ~ It is for freedom Christ has set us free; stand fast therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.*

When emotions are handled appropriately, they serve to help us understand ourselves and can be harnessed to bring us closer to God and others around us. It is God's desire for us to be free.




## GRACE RETREAT 2017 Annastazia's testimony

On the first morning of retreat, I took the bus from GII to KL. The journey lasted about 8 hours. I realized my left knee was locked and painful when I reached Pullman hotel. I was limping because of the pain. When I stood up and straightened my left leg, it got stiff and I could not bend it. I prayed and even did some stretching to relieve the pain but the pain persisted. It seemed as though my prayers weren't working.

Three years ago, I was diagnosed with lupus but my muscles had not weakened too badly since. However, I do have shoulder aches and stiffness in my legs/joints at times. I have been on medication so that I do not feel as fatigued. I would consider my lupus as under control. If I have pain in my body, it usually lasts for 10 minutes only. This time, however, the pain in my knee lasted 3 hours.

I still felt the pain as the first service began after dinner. Thankfully, I managed to sit through the entire session. At the time for altar ministry, I told myself that I needed to go up so that someone could pray with and for me. At that moment, Pastor Daniel's wife, Sister Doris came up to me and asked how she could pray for me. I told her about the pain on my left knee. She prayed with me. After 5 – 10 minutes, the pain had reduced noticeably. She told me that the pain would go off very soon. I returned to my room and prayed once more before going to bed. When I woke up the next morning, the pain was completely gone! I felt very relieved because I would not have wanted to be in pain throughout the whole retreat. Praise the Lord!

I thank God for healing me. I am also grateful He allowed me to attend the retreat and for the opportunity to hear Pastor Daniel's preaching. I also want to thank Ps Calvin & Ps Alvin and their committee for making this retreat happen.

# BEFRIEND AND IMPROVE LIVES!

Swee Eng and Sandy, 62 and 61 respectively, visit Mdm Lee, 70, fortnightly as part of the Community Befrienders Programme at REACH Community Services. Apart from chatting and keeping Mdm Lee company at her flat in Jurong East, the duo also brings Mdm Lee to the fitness corner in the neighbourhood for some light exercise.

Prior to the Befriending Programme, Mdm Lee spent most of her day at home, afraid to go out for fear of falling as she had a history of weak knees. Her son visits her in the morning to help with the housework and leaves before lunch. After which, no one would be at home with Mdm Lee.

When Swee Eng and Sandy were first assigned to visit Mdm Lee, they were excited to see how they can serve the lonely senior. Mdm Lee really appreciated the duo's company and often spent time outdoors, exercising and chatting away.

A typical visitation takes at least 1.5 hours and at the availability of the befrienders. When Swee Eng was travelling overseas and Sandy was on a mission trip to Myanmar in early September, the duo had to postpone the visitation to a week later. Mdm Lee expressed that she missed them very much, but was at the same time really glad to hear their travel stories.

Mdm Lee is more active now, and she looks forward to Swee Eng and Sandy's visit every fortnight because she knows they will be there to hear her out and accompany her.

The duo also visits Mr Lee, a paralytic. The fortnightly visits by Swee Eng and Sandy includes sitting by Mr Lee's bedside, telling him stories and singing songs to him. His face will light up and he will react by blinking and making eye contact when the duo sings oldies to him, though he is normally lifeless while resting in bed. Swee Eng tells us that his favourite music are the ones by Teresa Teng and Tsai Chin.

"It is a blessing that we have the strength and opportunity to befriend the seniors," says Sandy. "and they really treat us as their friends, I'm so thankful."



# 我的见证

罗马书十章十二节说，主对一切呼求祂的人是丰富的。享受主的路就是呼吸祂。主不但是丰富的，还是可亲近的，因为祂是赐生命的灵。

感谢主耶稣，今天能够在这里分享我和家人自从接受了主之后的微妙变化。

我今年48岁，已婚，家里有四个可爱又听话的孩子（17岁，16岁，12岁，9岁）。自小父亲就过世了，是母亲和大姐把我和姐姐们养大（我有六个姐姐），从小，母亲的信仰就是拜观音菩萨，所以我也就跟着母亲的脚步拜观音直到我有幸认识主耶稣为止。

我之前是一个非常虔诚的佛教徒，每逢初一、十五我都会用鲜花水果供奉我当时的信仰，焚烧市面上最上等的香，并且每一年当认识的几间庙宇做大日子的时候，我和太太都会捐钱帮忙庆祝。我们的捐款甚至于到达了泰国、马来西亚、印度、缅甸、斯里兰卡等国家。我也曾在2006年出家做了短期和尚。当时的我认为我已经找到了心里面渴求的归宿，一心奔着这个方向去的，直到....

2009年我设立的公司不小心触犯了法律，被劳工部起诉了。当时的我非常彷徨，不知道怎么办好，经朋友介绍认识了新加坡一个当时非常有威望的和尚。他怂恿我和太太拿出28万新币去投资他的项目，并且承诺会帮我解决我公司的法律问题。结果就如你们猜想的一样，钱打水漂了，2011年官司也打输了。打从那时起，我就对我的信仰怀疑起来了，心想我一路做好人做慈善，帮助过无数的人，我不偷不抢也没有骗人家的钱财，为什么我所一直侍奉的菩萨没有帮助我呢？

心中的疑虑和问号一直没有答案，直到我遇到了我的钻油台经理苏弟兄。这位苏弟兄曾经放弃了事业用了三年时间去了国外念神学，毕业后回到新加坡在我公司担任钻油台经理。他是第一个跟我分享主耶稣的人，经常导读圣经里面的经文让我知道。当时的我还没有接受主，只是把他的教导搁在心里的某一处。

2015年公司迎来了前所未有的经济不景气，我的公司钻油台的承包工程遇到了困难。公司在连续两年的亏损下迫切的需要银行的贷款来渡过难关。这时候的我每天都焦虑的来工作，每天都不断的跟自己的信仰祈求，晚上也没有办法睡上一个好觉。这样的日子从2016年尾一直折腾到2017年五月初，当时Spring Singapore已经通过的中小型企业贷款竟然被某家银行否决了。当时的我崩溃了，因为我知道我20年辛辛苦苦建立起来的事业跨了，紧接着就是家庭，孩子怎么办？

感谢主，苏弟兄在这艰难的时刻没有放弃我。他把腓利比书四章六节导读给了我。“应当一无挂虑，只要凡事藉着祷告，祈求，带着感谢，将你们所要的告诉神；神那超越人所能理解的平安，必在基督耶稣里，保卫你们的心怀意念。”因为看到了主耶稣的大爱，我和家人在五月二十七号受浸成了主的门徒。陈善瀚传道和惠兰姐妹也在过后的时间为我的家洁净祷告，心里感恩。

公司的问题依然存在，但是这时候的我知道，因为有了主耶稣的救赎和恩典，我能够坦然的接受接下来主要我经历的路，我心里得到了许久不曾有过的平安和勇气，过去的彷徨和无助已经远离了我。每当我被试探的时候，我都会呼求主名，主耶稣都会立刻指引我行在祂的意念之中。

信了主之后，更让我安慰的是，我太太和孩子都因为和我一起接受了主，全家更和谐，更快乐了，这是以往没有的喜悦，你能说主不伟大吗？虽然我们和主耶稣亲近的日子不长，但是看到老婆和孩子每一次藉圣灵的祷告，我知道我选择了一条正确的道路。

### *Testimony from Kunle & Folake Adeyeye, on the last module: The Life & Teachings of Paul by Dr Jerry Horner in April 2017*
